- This apartment is intended for accommodation only, so it is forbidden to hold or organize parties in it.
- No more people than those specified in its regulations (4 people) can be accommodated in the apartment.
- The tenants agree to maintain appropriate conduct to live in good relations with the neighbors, not to make noise inside or on the terrace of the apartment that could disturb the neighbors, as well as to use the community parts with great care, especially in term of noise and conservation of facilities.
- It is forbidden to introduce explosive or flammable materials or substances or others that may cause damage or discomfort to the other occupants of the property.
- The spaces where smoking is allowed are outdoors (terrace, balconies).
- Keep the floor clean.
- Leave the beds unmade at the end of the stay.
- Make good use of the facilities, equipment and utensils of the flat and of the community; If there are breakages or damage, the expenses will be charged to the amount delivered as a deposit.
- When you are going to leave the flat, you must leave the kitchen and the utensils you have used clean and collected, and throw away the rubbish.
- The keys will be left on the table on the day of departure and the door will be slammed. Take care of the sets of keys that we have given you.
- Turn off lights and air conditioners when you leave.
- Departures will be made before 12:00 on the last day of stay.
- If you use the Wi-Fi connection, you must know that the actions carried out during your stay in the apartment are your sole responsibility.
- The owner of the establishment may seek the assistance of the agents of the authority to evict users who fail to comply with the internal regulations or who intend to access or remain in them for a purpose other than the normal use of the service, in accordance with the provisions of article 32.2 of the Tourism Law.
